

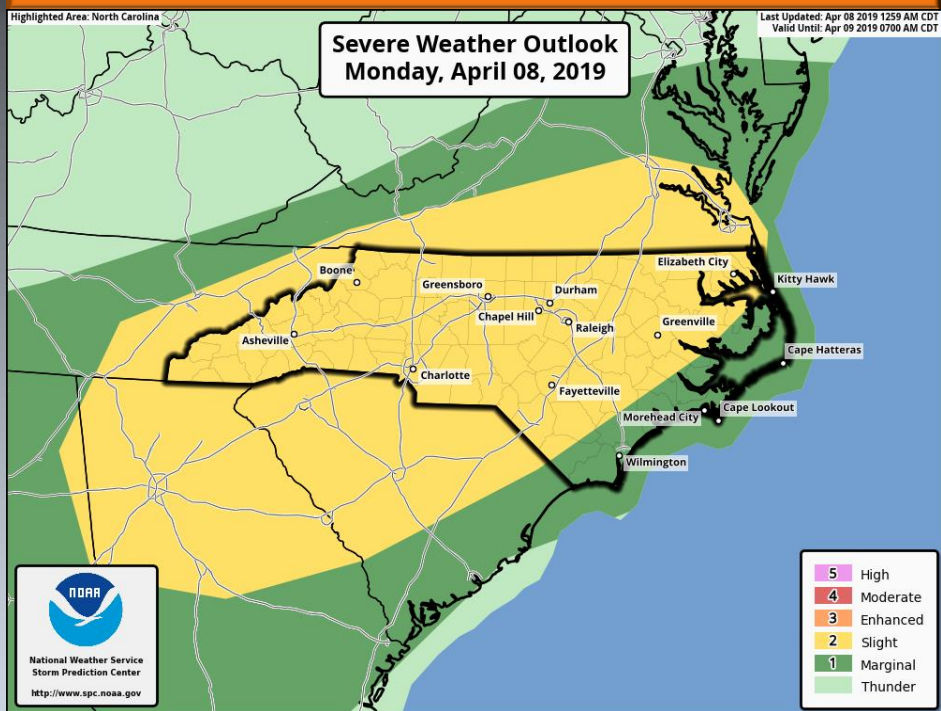


Severe Weather Outlook



There is a **SLIGHT** Risk for Severe Storms *this afternoon through this evening.*

Severe Risk Area



What to Expect

- Scattered to numerous thunderstorms are expected to develop and overspread central NC this afternoon through early tonight.
- Timing: *Mostly between 3 PM and midnight.*
- Locations: All of central North Carolina, though with a slightly lesser potential over the Coastal Plain.
- The most intense storms could produce all hazards, including **damaging wind gusts, large hail, an isolated tornado, and localized flooding.**
