




# Severe Weather Outlook



Potential for strong to severe storms this afternoon through early evening

## Severe Risk Area



## What to Expect

- Clusters of showers and storms will move from SC into south central NC today
- Timing: *Mainly 3 pm to 8 pm*
- Locations: The southern half of central NC, along and south of a line from near Albemarle to Sanford to Goldsboro
- The most intense storms could produce **damaging wind gusts and large hail up to the size of quarters**. A weak tornado can't be ruled out.
