FAR TOO OFTEN FIRE DEPARTMENTS SPEC FIRE APPARATUS WITHOUT MUCH THOUGHT FOR PORTABLE GROUND LADDERS. MOST FIGURE THE AERIAL WILL MAKE THE RESCUE, BUT MANY MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS DO NOT HAVE ACCESS FOR THESE LARGE RIGS. THIS CLASS WILL TAKE THE STUDENT THROUGH A CASE STUDY OF MULTIPLE PORTABLE LADDER RESCUES AS WELL AS DISCUSS PORTABLE LADDER SPEC, CONSTRUCTION AND CAPABILITIES.

SCENARIOS

THE SEARCH TRACK

STUDENTS WILL BE SPLIT INTO GROUPS AND ROTATE THROUGH 4 DIFFERENT STATIONS INVOLVING DIFFERENT SEARCH TECHNIQUES. THE 4 STATIONS ARE CAN SEARCH, DYFJ FORCE, VES 1ST FLOOR, & VES BEYOND THE DOOR. CAN SEARCH WILL ALLOW STUDENTS TO HONE IN ON SKILLS INVOLVING SEARCHING WITH A WATER CAN AHEAD OF A HOSE LINE. DYFJ SEARCH TEACHES STUDENTS THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING SMOOTH AND FAST. STUDENTS WILL BE TASKED WITH FORCING DOORS, MASKING UP QUICKLY AND PERFORMING A SEARCH OF THE ENTRYWAY AND FARTHER. VES 1ST FLOOR WILL HELP STUDENTS DISCREDIT MYTHS AND FEARS INVOLVING VES. VES BEYOND THE DOOR WILL ALLOW STUDENTS TO THINK OUTSIDE THE BOX AND GO BEYOND A SINGLE ROOM OCCUPANCY THROUGH THE VES SEARCH CONCEPT.

THE STRETCH TRACK

STUDENTS WILL BE SPLIT INTO GROUPS AND ROTATE THROUGH TWO MAIN STATIONS. THE FIRST STATION THE ATE UP ENGINE, WILL OPEN THE MINDS OF STUDENTS BY ALLOWING THEM TO PRACTICE DIFFERENT STRETCHING TECHNIQUES AND HOSE LOADS. STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO COMPARE DIFFERENT HOSE CONSTRUCTION TYPES AND COMPLETE PACKAGES WHILE FLOWING, STRETCHING AND MOVING LINES THROUGH DIFFERENT SETUPS. STRETCHING LONG AND TALL HELPS STUDENTS PREPARE FOR SITUATIONS INVOLVING LONG LINES AND VERTICAL LINE PLACEMENT. STRETCHING AND FLOWING LINES OVER 300 FEET AND FLOWING FROM THE THIRD FLOOR AND HIGHER IS THE NAME OF THE GAME HERE.

USING MORE THAN 250 ACQUIRED STRUCTURES, FROM SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLINGS TO LARGE, MULTISTORY HIGH-RISES, THIS LECTURE PRESENTS AN INSIGHT INTO TRUCK COMPANY TACTICS THAT HAVE BEEN PROVEN AND IMPLEMENTED ON THE FIREGROUND. TOPICS SPAN FROM FORCIBLE ENTRY AND VERTICAL VENTILATION TO WINDOW-TO-DOOR CONVERSIONS TO RESEARCHED DRILLS.
