This sample map allows for the streamlining of zones amongst departments who operate together daily.
This also allows for the introduction of two dedicated LZ talkgroups for the Piedmont.

Although the naming may change slightly, this is just a recommendation

DYNAMIC would allow the departments to individually create a EZ zone that would not require the county to program each radio. Resulting in one master codeplug

Reduced to five working zones with a dynamic programable zone per department choice.
Departments are gathered with their most frequent AA in the geo locaiton they are positioned
<i>Future Use</i> Spaces reserved for future additional talk groups as theu are needed.
Remove PS HELP from channel 1 - revert TG should be set to any TG that isnt a tac or direct.

This map shows the removal of PSHELP from the Channel 1 position - this should be acceptable as per the operations of departments are to declare a MAY DAY tactically on the current operating channel of an incident. Also with the reduction of multiple trunking personalities to just two personalities - REVERT and TACTICAL for emergency button press. All dispatch talk groups, and state talk groups will be from the REVERT personality thus when a emergency button is pressed the radio will change the channel to PS HELP with out the user needing in other action.
TACTICAL will serve for the use of TAC channel where the radio will acitvate in emergency once the firefighter has exhausted the accepted communicatoin plan for declaring an emergency.

The removal of the GOLF zone witht the EMS and Law enforcement talk groups would be acceptable with the use of the Interop zone. Given the definition of interoperability this option makes most sense and would truly familiarize personnel with the use of the INTEROP zone and the reduction of duplicated talk groups.

ZONE Naming - this is not a requirement and only made the grouping of departments easier based of geographic locatoin.
