There's good news for North Carolinians 65 years and older. A tested, safe and effective COVID-19 vaccination is ready for you. Supplies are limited—and you may have to wait. But you have one of the first spots to take your shot.

More than 70,000 people volunteered in clinical trials that showed the vaccines were safe and 95% effective—with no serious safety concerns. There are possible temporary reactions like a sore arm, headache or feeling tired and achy for a day or two.

Your local health department or hospital can help you get your shot.
