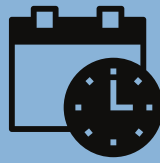

Weekly Highlights: October 1, 2021

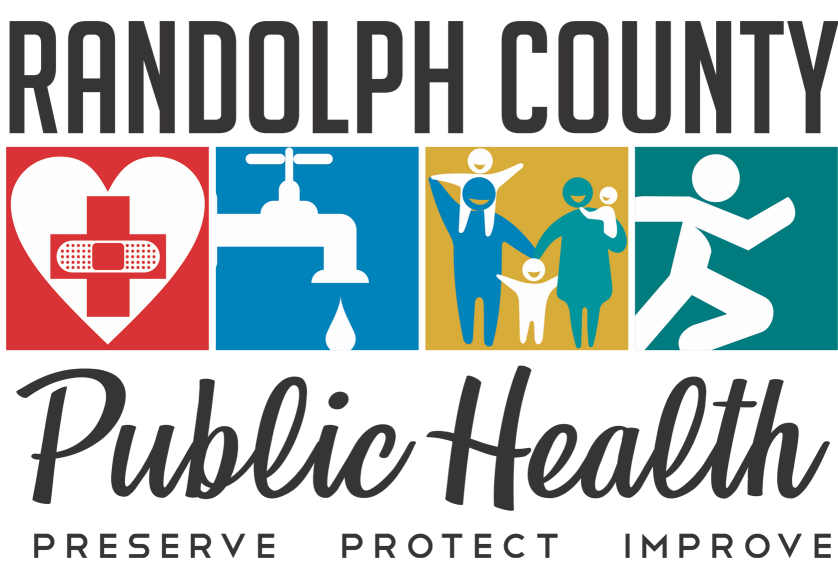

- At RCPH, vaccines are currently available for anyone 12 years of age and older (Pfizer). For those that are interested in getting the COVID-19 vaccine, call our appointment line at 336-365-6110 to schedule an appointment. For individuals deaf or hard of hearing (TTY), call 336-318-6201. The appointment line is open Monday - Friday, 8:30am to 4:00pm as appointments are available.
- RCPH is offering a 3rd dose of Moderna and Pfizer to those who are **moderately to severely immunocompromised**.

COVID-19 Vaccine Booster (Pfizer)



CDC recommends:

Individuals 65 years and older or residents in long-term care settings should receive a Pfizer booster

Individuals aged 50-64 with certain underlying conditions should receive a Pfizer booster

Individuals aged 18-49 with certain underlying conditions may receive a Pfizer booster

Individuals aged 18-64 at high risk to COVID-19 exposure due to occupational or institutional setting may receive a Pfizer booster

The single booster vaccine has to be given **at least 6 months** after the 2nd dose of Pfizer.

CDC recomienda:

Personas 65 años y mayores o residentes de entornos de cuidado a largo plazo debe recibir un refuerzo de Pfizer

Personas de 50 a 64 años de edad con afecciones subyacentes debe recibir un refuerzo de Pfizer

Personas de 18 a 49 años con afecciones subyacentes puede recibir un refuerzo de Pfizer

Personas de 18 a 64 años de edad con mayor riesgo de exposición y transmisión del COVID-19 por su entorno ocupacional y institucional puede recibir un refuerzo de Pfizer

El refuerzo de la vacuna se deber dar **por lo menos 6 meses** despues de la segunda dosis de Pfizer.

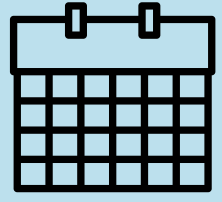

Nasal Swab (PCR) Test - No Cost

- Results available within 72 hours or less.*
- Providers will contact patients via text message with positive or negative results.

* Exceptions may apply with inconclusive results.

The PCR test is covered by insurance or submitted for reimbursement through the CARES Act.

**Registration on site or
text the word "COVID" to 704-850-6996 to pre-register.**

Testing sites may be closed early, delayed or canceled when there is severe weather.

Optional Rapid Blood Antibody Test - \$50

Can determine if someone was PREVIOUSLY infected.

- Results available within 5-10 minutes of being administered

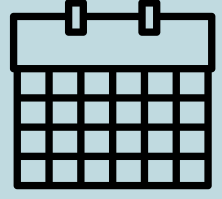

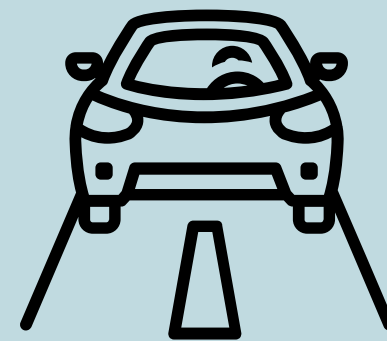
