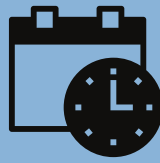
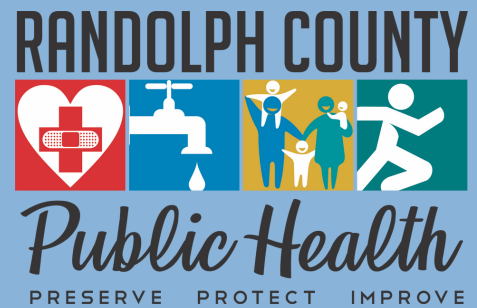

## Weekly Highlights: October 8, 2021

- At RCPH, vaccines are currently available for anyone 12 years of age and older (Pfizer). For those that are interested in getting the COVID-19 vaccine, call our appointment line at 336-365-6110 to schedule an appointment. For individuals deaf or hard of hearing (TTY), call 336-318-6201. The appointment line is open Monday - Friday, 8:30am to 4:00pm as appointments are available.
- RCPH is offering a 3rd dose of Moderna and Pfizer to those who are **moderately to severely immunocompromised**.
