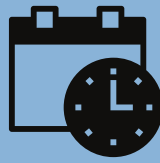
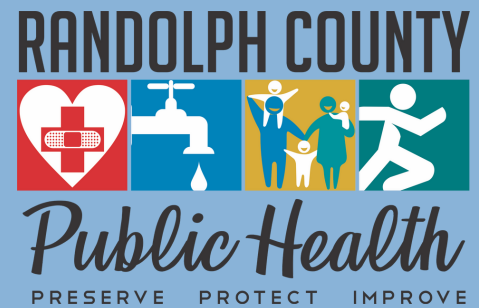

- At RCPH, vaccines are currently available for anyone 5 years of age and older (Pfizer). For those that are interested in getting the COVID-19 vaccine, call our appointment line at 336-365-6110 to schedule an appointment. For individuals deaf or hard of hearing (TTY), call 336-318-6201. The appointment line is open Monday - Friday, 8:30am to 4:00pm (excluding holidays) as appointments are available.
 - RCPH is now scheduling appointment for booster doses (Pfizer) for those aged 16-17. Parental consent is required.
 - RCPH is now scheduling appointments for booster doses of Moderna and Pfizer for those aged 18 and older.
 - RCPH is offering appointments for pediatric vaccines for those aged 5-11 (Pfizer).
