
COVID-19 1/7/22





Weekly Highlights: January 7, 2022

- At RCPH, vaccines are currently available for anyone 5 years of age and older (Pfizer). For those that are interested in getting the COVID-19 vaccine, call our appointment line at 336-365-6110 to schedule an appointment. For individuals deaf or hard of hearing (TTY), call 336-318-6201. The appointment line is open Monday Friday, 8:30am to 4:00pm (excluding holidays) as appointments are available.
 - RCPH is now scheduling appointments for booster doses (Pfizer) for those aged 12-17. Parental consent is required.
 - RCPH is now scheduling appointments for booster doses of Moderna and Pfizer for those aged 18 and older. It is now 5 months after primary series for those who received Pfizer and 6 months after primary series for those who received Moderna.
 - RCPH is offering appointments for pediatric vaccines for those aged 5-11 (Pfizer).
 - RCPH is offering a 3rd dose of Moderna and Pfizer to those who are moderately to severely immunocompromised, **including children ages 5-11 (Pfizer only)**. To see if you are eligible, visit: <u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/booster-shot.html</u>
