




Upcoming Weekend Storm



What has changed?

Confidence increasing for more rain than frozen precipitation

What we know:

- Precipitation begins Saturday night (30-70% chance), bulk of precipitation falls on Sunday (80-90% chance), precipitation ends late Sunday night (40-60% chance).
- A wintry mix of rain/sleet/freezing rain/snow is expected during this time frame. Accumulating snow is most likely in western counties, including the Triad.

What we don't know:

- Exact timing and track of storm system, which impacts areal coverage and type of precipitation, as well as amounts.

The system remains out over the Pacific Ocean! Once it moves over land early Thursday, upper air balloons will be able to supplement satellite data on the system, which will help the models come into better agreement.
