The appointment line is open Monday - Friday, 8:30am to 4:00pm (excluding holidays) as appointments are available.
 - o RCPH is now scheduling appointments for booster doses (Pfizer) for those aged 12-17. Parental consent is required.
 - RCPH is now scheduling appointments for booster doses of Moderna and Pfizer for those aged 18 and older. It is now 5 months after primary series for those who received Pfizer or Moderna.
 - RCPH is offering appointments for pediatric vaccines for those aged 5-11 (Pfizer).
