 - RCPH is now scheduling appointments for booster doses (Pfizer) for those aged 12-17 (parental consent is required).
 - RCPH is now scheduling appointments for booster doses of Moderna and Pfizer for those aged 18 and older. It is now 5 months after primary series for those who received Pfizer or Moderna.
