"A critical incident is any situation faced by emergency service personnel that causes them to experience unusually strong emotional reactions which have the potential to interfere with their ability to function either at the scene or later."

OUR SERVICES

Critical Incident Stress Management is a Comprehensive, Integrated, Systematic, and Multi – component approach to crisis or disaster intervention. It is a strategic intervention system which possesses numerous tactical interventions including:

- Defusing
- Demobilizations Debriefing (CISD)
- One on one intervention Consultation
- Psychological first aid (PFA) Follow-up
- Community intervention Referral

EXAMPLES OF CRITICAL INCIDENTS

- Line of duty death of a co-worker
- Serious injury of a co-worker on the job
- Prolonged rescue or recovery operations
- Death of a child
- Mass casualty incidents
- Operations with intense media coverage
- Terrorist actions
- ANY incident with high emotional impact on responders
