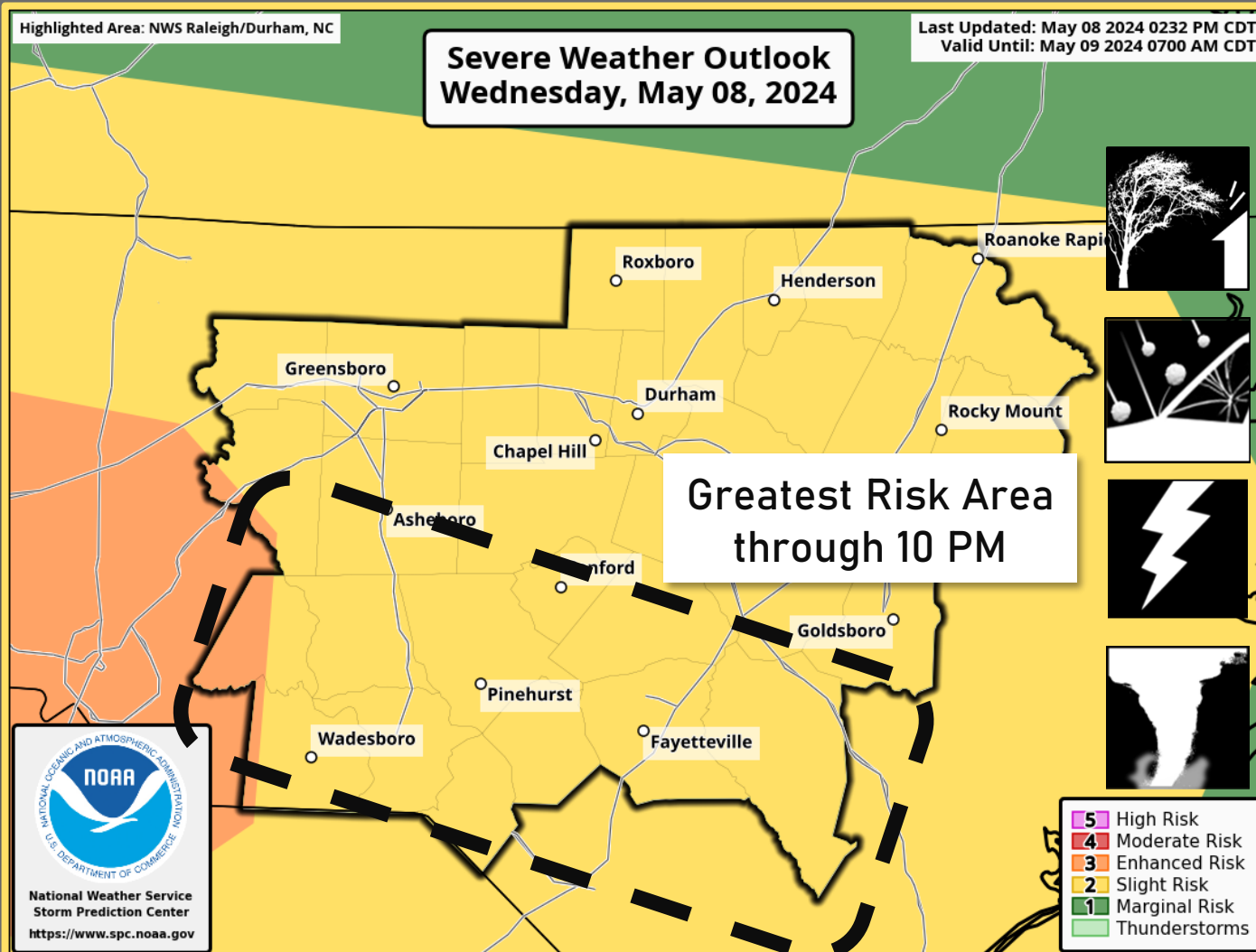


Wednesday, May 8th

When Thunder Roars, Go Indoors!

Threat Level 2 out of 5

Slight Risk



Overview

- Multiple rounds of strong to severe storms are possible across the area this afternoon and tonight.

Timing

- Primary threat: late afternoon/evening
- Secondary threat: overnight into early Thursday morning

Hazards

- Damaging winds and large hail
- Isolated tornado can't be ruled out

What does a **Slight Risk** Mean?

Scattered severe thunderstorms possible. Short-lived and/or not widespread, isolated intense storms possible



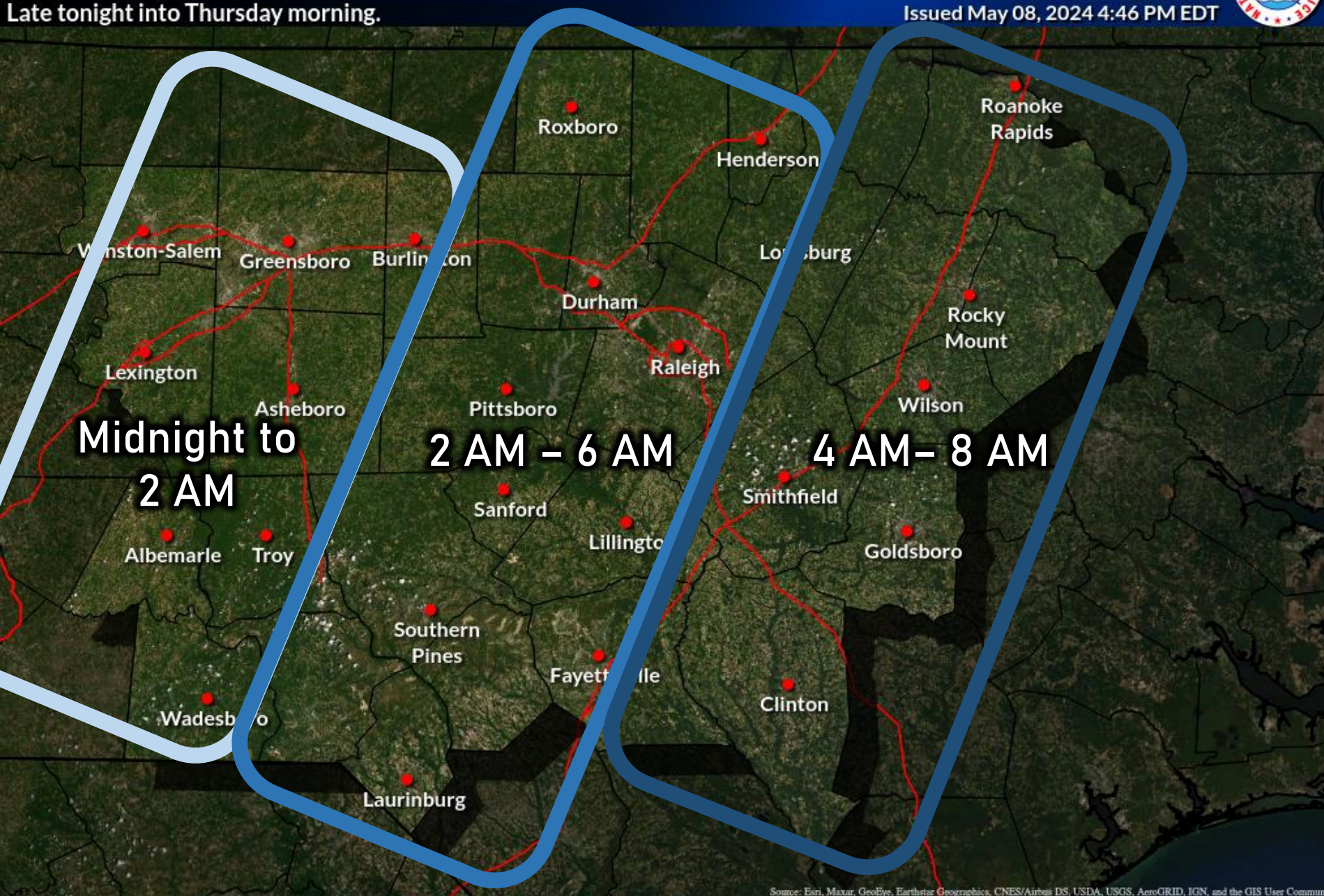
Round 2 Timing Graphic

Second round of strong/severe storms

Damaging straight-line winds will be the primary threat

We may see a weakening trend as this line moves east through the area

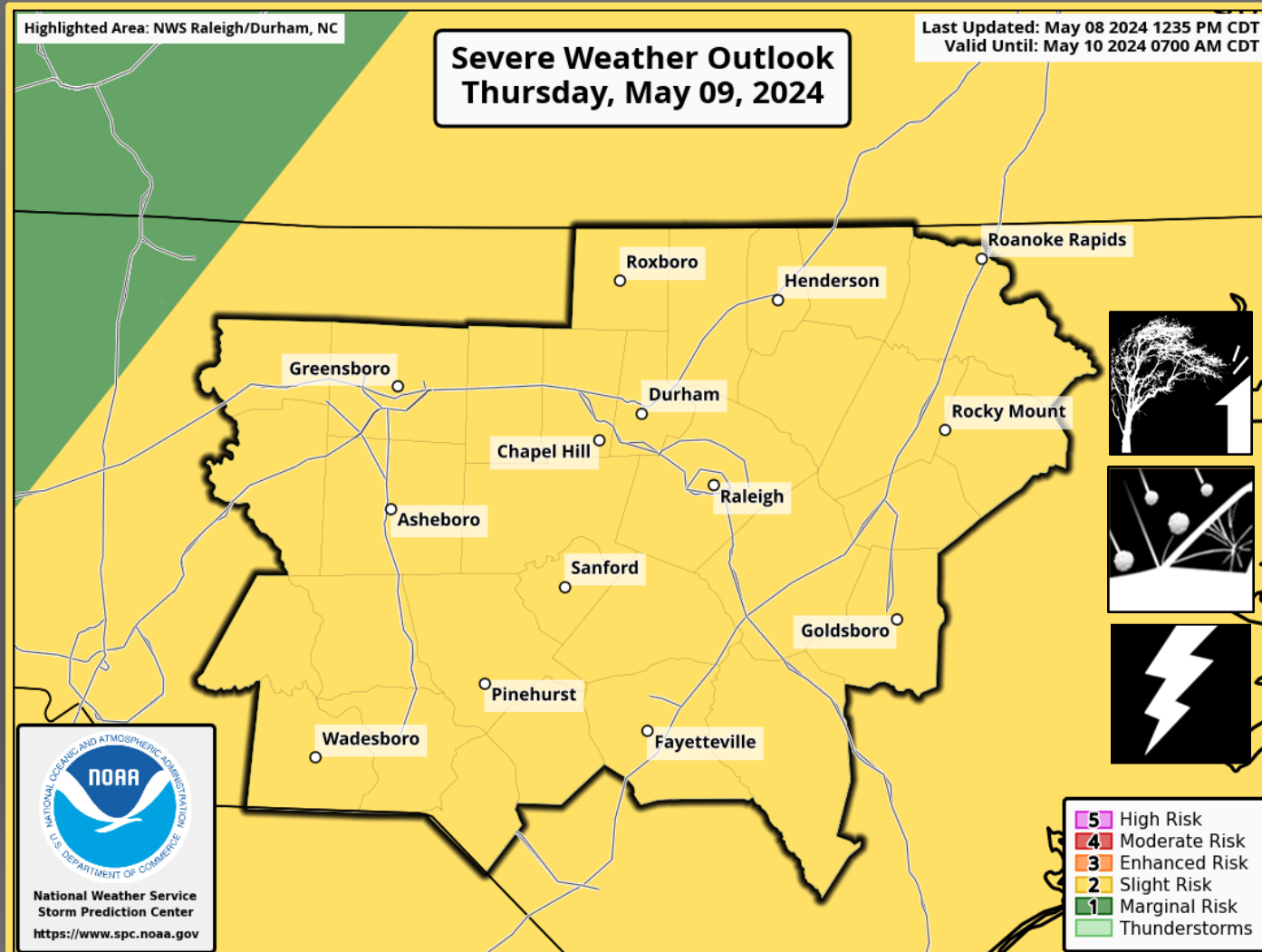

Overview

- Forecast confidence is low regarding details. A threat of severe storms will continue into Thursday, but may be more isolated/scattered in nature.

Timing

- Thursday morning into early afternoon, potentially lingering into early evening

Hazards

- Damaging winds and large hail

What does a **Slight Risk** Mean?

Scattered severe thunderstorms possible. Short-lived and/or not widespread, isolated intense storms possible
