




# Weekly Impact Weather Briefing for Central North Carolina


Covering the period Monday through Sunday February 18-24, 2019







#### This Week's Weather Pattern




#### **Severe Thunderstorm Potential**





**Next 72 Hours** 



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

## 7- Day Accumulated Precipitation Forecasts





#### **8-14 Day Precipitation Outlook**








#### Wintry Mix Possible Mid-week

#### **Important Details**

- A wintry mix of snow/sleet/rain is expected to develop on Tuesday evening across northern portions of central NC. The wintry mix will change to freezing rain early Wednesday morning, with light ice accumulations possible. Little to no snow and sleet accumulations are expected.
- **Timing: Tuesday Night -> Wednesday** morning.
- **Location: Northern Piedmont and Northern** Coastal Plain.
- **Impacts: Hazardous travel conditions** possible, especially on elevated surfaces such as bridges and overpasses, or on any untreated roadways.

# **Summary For the Week**

- Wet weather pattern sticks around for the next 5 to 6 days
- Heaviest rainfall amounts along and west of the NC Mountains, but 1 to 3 inches possible over next 7 days locally
- Wintry mix possible Tuesday night -> Wednesday AM with minor impacts possible near/north of I-85
- Variable temps throughout the week
- No drought concerns
- Limited river flooding concerns (for now)
