

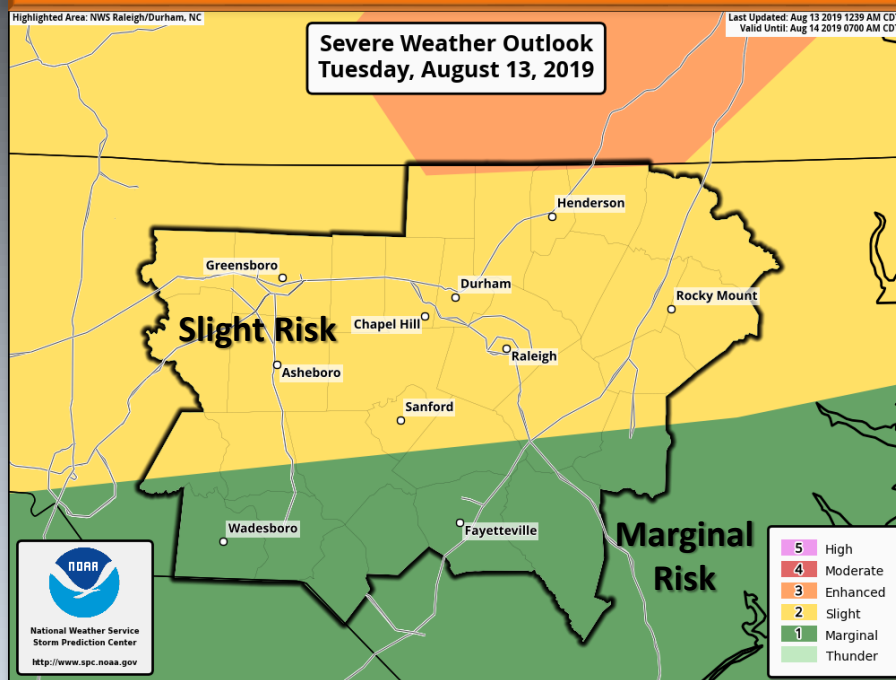


Severe Weather Outlook



There is a slight risk for severe weather **this afternoon/evening**.

Severe Risk Area



What to Expect

- **Overview:** Scattered strong to severe storms are expected late this afternoon and evening, likely to persist into the overnight hours.
- **Locations:** All of central NC.
- **Timing:** Between 4 PM and Midnight
- **Hazards and Impacts:** Damaging wind gusts, hail, lightning, and locally heavy rainfall that could lead to pockets of urban and small stream flooding will be possible.
