Advanced Rope and Rigging Operations

Training tower High Angle Rope Operations...

This training event will allow the attendee to participate in high angle rescue operations. High Lines from drill tower to lower anchor point. Participants will have the opportunity to establish anchor points, set up rigging operations and deploy high lines for the purposes of rescue and/or recovery. Trainees will learn the tools of the trade through top notch instruction and practical applications.

Flash Over training, Thermal Imaging, Ventilation

The participant will gain first-hand knowledge of why flashover occurs and the recognition of when a flashover is about to occur and what it looks/feels like when the event actually happens. This course will provide the student with tips and techniques to prevent flashover from occurring. The importance of proper tool selection, crew integrity, and fireground communication will also be covered. A signed release from department Chief will be required for participation.
