What to Expect

- Scattered thunderstorms are expected across central and eastern North Carolina this afternoon and evening.
- Timing: Today 3pm 11pm
- **Locations: All of Central North Carolina** particularly along and east of US highway 1
- Impacts: Some of the stronger storms could produce straight line winds in excess of 50 mph or an isolated tornado. Downed trees and isolated power outages are possible.
