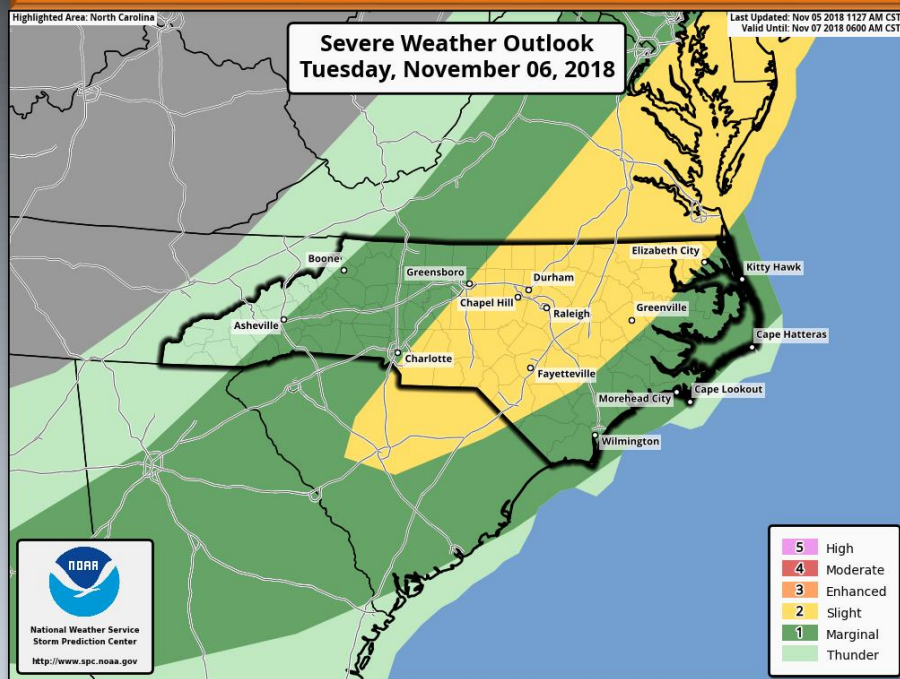




# Severe Weather Outlook for Tuesday

## What to Expect

- **Overview:** A line of strong to severe storms will sweep across central North Carolina on Tuesday.
- **Locations:** All of Central North Carolina.
- **Timing:**
  - Mid-day Tuesday for the Triad and western Piedmont.
  - Tuesday afternoon for the central Piedmont, the Triangle region, and the Sandhills region.
  - Late afternoon and evening for the I-95 corridor and Coastal Plain regions.
- **Hazards and Impacts:** The line of storms will have a wind damage threat along the leading edge, capable of downing trees. An isolated tornado threat will also be possible with rotating cells embedded in the line.
